Here are two defining verses that teaches us what Jesus had done.

John 12:49

New International Version

49 For I did not speak on my own, but the Father who sent me commanded me(A) to say all that I have spoken.

John 5:19-20

New International Version

19 Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself;(A) he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. 20 For the Father loves the Son(B) and shows him

all he does. Yes, and he will show him even greater works than these,(C) so that you will be amazed.

John 15:5

New International Version

5 "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit;(A) apart from me you can do nothing.

If Jesus has to hear what God says and only says what God has commanded then it shows that we too have to hear what Jesus has to say and only say what Jesus tells us. Similarly Jesus can only do those miracles that the Father shows him. And without him, without his approval or permission, we can do nothing as he had mentioned, so how come nowadays Christians can by their own imagination do whatever they desire without Jesus approval and expecting miracles to occur.

Lamentations 3:37-38

New International Version

37 Who can speak and have it happen
