What is True Faith?

Most people don't really understand the meaning of Faith. Let alone the word True Faith. Faith is not something you can conjure by forcing yourself to believe in some words or concepts. His given word is not only encompassing the Bible written words, it can also include His Spoken Word. The Bible states that True Faith comes from hearing God's voice as in His Spoken Word. God can also use scripture to speak to us by quickening the scripture through His Holy Spirit. This quickened scripture becomes a Sent Word from the Lord. Romans 10:17 (New King James Version)

17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

In this scripture, God said True Faith comes by hearing. And hearing is possible when we get the Word from God from his own mouth or from the Holy Spirit quicken scripture. God has to send you his Word before you can exercise your faith based on His Word to you. Not any scripture that you desire by choosing it yourself. It has to be a Holy Spirit of God or Jesus Given Word to you, God's Given Word is like an Imperial Edict, once it is issued it will accomplish whatever the Word says one hundred percent of the time.

Psalm 107:20 (King James Version)

20 He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Isaiah 50:4 (King James Version)

4 The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned.

Isaiah 55:10-11 (New International Version)

10 As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater,

11 so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

How did God give Isaiah a learned tongue to speak a Word in Season to sustain the weary? Isaiah could hear the Voice of God telling him what to say or do, just like Jesus.

Isaiah 38:5 (New International Version)

5 "Go and tell Hezekiah, 'This is what the LORD, the God of your father David, says: I have heard your prayer and seen your tears; I will add fifteen years to your life.

God has to send us His Word before anything can happen. God told and instructed Isaiah what to say and Isaiah said the same thing to King Hezekiah and he lived for another 15 years. If we use our own words nothing can happen because Jesus said without me you can do nothing. If we leave Jesus out of whatever we are doing nothing happens. We must ask Jesus what he wants to do for the person and not just used our own thinking and say something so that it puts Jesus on the spot and force him to do whatever we proclaim because we use the "Word of Faith" that's not his words. We can never know the mind of Jesus unless we asked him. The Word of Faith assumes that Jesus wants to heal everyone all the time. That's not so.

John 15:5 (New International Version)

5 "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

That's why Word of Faith can work only 50 percent of the time, because its either the person gets healed or they are not, so it's a 50 percent chance that they get it right. But that's not God's way. God's way is 100 percent of the time right when you get the His Word on the matter, you can know if the person will be healed or not when Jesus speaks to you. I tell you the truth, it's not always God's will that everyone we prayed for gets healed. With Jesus all things are possible. Without Jesus, we can do no miracles nor even bless someone. Our words will fall to the ground; totally useless.

Have you ever heard of self-deliverance? I have never heard that this can be done. Yet, when I heard Jesus tells me to say to my spirit of nicotine to call it to come out of my body, I experienced a deep vomit and the spirit came out. In that instance, I was totally free from the nicotine addiction.
