You can hear the Voice of God outside the Bible

Contrary to convention thinking that hearing the voice of God can only happen when you read your bible, God actually is more omnipotent than what the preachers have been preaching. Some claimed that God don't speak to you anymore because he became lazy after he had given a book, essentially an encyclopedia of his words and all that he does is to used those words in a limited bible to talk to you. Little wonder why those Christians who subscribe to this kind of theology aren't living an overcoming life. It is written, that man shall not live on bread alone but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God. How did I begin to hear the voice of God?

Matthew 4:4 New International Version

4 Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'[a]"

This is how I explained this verse, that is the bread is the bible, because Jesus says he is the bread of life. And the word that proceeds from the mouth of God is actually God's spoken words. Because I believe therefore God made it possible for me to hear his voice.

Mark 9:23 New King James Version

23 Jesus said to him, "If[a] you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

Therefore, as I believe, Jesus made it possible for me to hear his voice. Exactly just as the bible said so. Here are three testimonies which showed that I have heard the quiet voice of God in my spirit.

The first occasion in which I heard the voice of God is when I was going through a rough period in my life and needed some encouragement from the Lord. One morning as I was heading to work, I asked the Lord if he loves me. Then suddenly I heard the words, "wait 10 minutes". It was already 7.50 am and so I waited until its 8.00 am before starting my car and driving onto the Pan Island Express Way. After driving for a few seconds, a shalom van suddenly cuts into my path, I had to slow down for a moment and then as I looked closer there was these words, "JESUS LOVES YOU". Do I still need to test if I had heard the voice of Jesus anymore? I guess not. God speaks to me to reaffirm and encourage me.

On the second occasion, as I was reading my bible at night about 11.00 pm, I saw in a vision this particular lady and she was praying in the old Chinese opera style with long hair swirling as in agony, Then I heard the voice of Jesus telling me to message her by sending her an SMS with just these two words, "Call me". After sending it, there was no reply for about 15 minutes and I asked the Lord, did I hear wrongly. The Lord said again, send her the same message, "Call me", because she wants a confirmation. The typical Christian style. So, after I had sent her the second message, she called my handphone.

I took the call and asked her why she was praying with so much agony and grief. She said she needed money to pay rent, so I asked her how much for the rent, she said \$1500. So, I said I will pray about it, then she told me she actually needed \$2000 so I asked why the extra \$500, she told me she needed it for her living expenses. After this call, I asked the Lord who should pay, then the Lord said "You must be very stupid or slow, if I asked her to call you then should you pay for her?". But I said, I don't have this money. The Lord reminded me that someone had given me an offering of \$2000 and that was prepared for her. So. I immediately call the lady and asked her to come to my office and take the check. God speaks to me to help someone.

This third occasion happened when I keep having the impression of a certain other lady in my church. Her image keeps popping up in my mind, but I told the Lord, I don't know her address. But the Lord told me to message another lady church friend, and true enough this lady had her address. I waited until Saturday to visit her because it was inconvenient for me to visit her during the week days. The constant impression didn't register to me that she was in urgent need. As I was going to visit her, I told the Lord that I don't know how to get there by bus. The Lord said, "you mean you don't have money to take a taxi there?" I decided to take a taxi, but the Lord said, "Wait, you needed to withdraw \$100" So I obeyed. Then I also decided to give her 2 books. When I reached her place, she was surprised and invited me into her house, I then proceeded to ask her what was going on for the last 5 days. What she told me shocked me. She said, her husband had beaten her and she had prayed earnestly to God to get someone to help her, as she had no money to buy food. And she said God didn't send anyone. I was too shy to say God did but I didn't know it was me. I quietly put the \$100 dollars bill into the books as she poured drinks for me and I told her please read these books. Hoping she will find the money inside. Again, Jesus had used me to help someone in need. God will not talk to you for nothing, he has a purpose. So do I need to check if God had spoken to me again, I don't because when I hear, I obey then I find out why. You need to listen then obey to discover if God had spoken to you. That's the only way. But truthfully, God will not ask you to commit a sin or do things that goes against his principles.

In all three instances, I heard God and they don't fit any bible scriptures at all. Because none of the Words of God can be found in the bible. That's why when people teach that you can use the bible scripture to confirm if you have heard from God is totally not applicable in these three of my cases. These people must be teaching those things through a theologically correct point of view but practically very mechanical and dogmatic in nature. It only tells me these teachers hadn't experience much in hearing the voice of God.

They are too legalistic, making God very impractical. In truth, God speaks to me as normal as my natural father speaking to me and he doesn't use scripture all the time. I hear him speaking to me in my head. But I can hear him clearly after God had delivered me from many spiritual uncleanness within my soul. I do believe that spiritual deliverance is one the key to hearing the voice of God. That's because these unclean spirits will confuse you by casting doubts on your hearing. The other key is the constant sincere wanting to know how to be a good Christian by reading and obeying the Commandments, Decrees and Statutes of God written in the bible. By reading the bible, you can become familiar with the ways of God. Finally, the willingness to listen, believe and obey, will help you get started in being able to hear the Voice of God. But without the courage to find out, you will never be able to experience hearing the Voice of God.
