

# Can you read the Bible without the Holy Spirit guidance?

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Can anyone read the bible? Of course, you can. Anyone can read the bible like a story book. But to truly read, understand and apply, you will need the Holy Spirit to guide you. The wisdom in the bible can only be opened by the Holy Spirit to give us the eyes of understanding. The Holy Spirit of God is the same Spirit of God. It's a sent portion of the Spirit of God into all true believers who are approved by Jesus for salvation. For salvation is found in no other name, other than the name of Jesus. Jesus says the secret to the kingdom of God is only given to his chosen ones or disciples. But to others it would be like a parable, hard for the non-initiated to understand. Jesus promises to give the Holy Spirit which is the Spirit of Truth and his job is to guide us into all truth in the Bible or God's written words. Only the Holy Spirit of God can give us the wisdom, knowledge and understanding required to read the Bible. Jesus said the words I speak to you are full of Spirit and Life.

John 6:63 (New International Version)

63 The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you—they are full of the Spirit[a] and life.

It means that the words contain the Spirit, so without the Holy Spirit activating the word of Jesus, it will never give forth its meaning to the reader. This is the reason why even the theologians and the bible teachers have not much differing understanding in their bible interpretation. This has resulted in those moving in the Spirit and those who believe in the written word only. Those who are bible only believers don't possess the Spirit of discernment and they therefore use their intellect to try to infer what the bible says; thus, they need to use exegesis methodology, a mechanical means to understand a statement to make it theoretically correct instead of relying on the Holy Spirit as commanded in the bible. Yet they all claimed that they believe in the bible. What did the bible say?

1 Corinthians 2:14 (New International Version)

14 The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit.

The bible truly says that the carnal man using his human intellect can never discern what the bible says because it is spiritually discerned and the Spirit filled man makes judgement about everything that the Holy Spirit taught and he is not under anyone's criticism. But because the ones with the Holy Spirit and the ones without cannot be differentiated by outward appearances, it becomes very hard to tell who is faking this anointing. Only the ones with the true anointing of the Holy Spirit of God can have the overcomer's life. That's why the bible-only ministers will laugh at the Spirit-filled Christians because they find them foolish. To the bible-only Christians moving in the Holy Spirit is dangerous. That's only true if you don't have the Holy Spirit but assume or pretend that the Holy Spirit is speaking through you. That falls under false witnessing and God will punish them. So, there is no fear what will happen to the fake Spirit filled Christians in the end. Let God be the judge.

Proverbs 19:9 (New International Version)

9 A false witness will not go unpunished, and whoever pours out lies will perish.

In fact, the book of Proverbs mentioned three times what will happen to the false witnesses who spread lies. The sin of leading people astray is so severe that God has to caution is three times as in Proverbs 19:5, 19:9 and 21:28.

If Jesus says His words is Spirit and life then he would need to give us a way into the Spirit for us to be able to read and understand what He is saying, right? Because He said the secret to the Kingdom of God is only given to his disciples, the true disciples. Those who don't belong to the true disciples all came by the back door and the windows; only true disciples came in by the front door. It is written,

Matthew 11:12 (New King James Version)

12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force.

Aggressive people are trying to enter into the Kingdom of God by force. Even though they don't truly understand the bible, yet they still teach it as though they know. Thus, leading many astray from the already True Narrow Path. This Narrow Path is the way of the Holy Spirit led Christian life. These teachers got their credibility through human endeavour, they didn't get the true approval from Jesus, who is alive and well in heaven. That's why they couldn't heal anyone by using their PhD certificates. They have head knowledge but don't have the Holy Spirit of power, because they never got the anointing from God. They had no Pentecostal experience. That equates to not getting the approval of Jesus to minister in His power. Therefore, they invented the cessation theory, that after we have the bible all such works of power ceased. These are cunning, haughty, educated, knowledgeable people; a wicked generation.

2 Timothy 3:1-5 (New King James Version)

3 But know this, that in the last days [a]perilous times will come: 2 For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3 unloving, [b]unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, 4 traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

All teachers who have a form of godliness but denying the power of God fall into this category as the ones above. They thought that this verse only refers to the lovers of money boasters and lovers of pleasure only but they are wrong, it includes people who deny the power of God. It refers to them having a form that looks like being godly. Like the teachers and ministers of the Gospel. Anyone who loves money, preaching for money, anyone who are headstrong believing in the cessation theory, traitors of the gospel of God declaring the Word of Faith from the imagination of their flesh, these people are all included in this verse alone. Yet they don't even know this, because every time they read this verse, their minds will point to others not themselves. They don't know the bible is Spirit filled and its always talking to us when we read it. How can they know this truth if they don't even have the Holy Spirit in them?

2 Timothy 3:6-7 (New King James Version)

6 For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts, 7 always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Thus, they make captives of gullible women who are loaded down with sins, and they themselves are forever learning never coming to the knowledge of the Truth in the bible. The Spirit in the Bible will actually repel these people from gaining the true knowledge that is only reserved for the true disciple of Jesus because Jesus gave them the key to this understanding, which is the Holy Spirit of God. There are seven spiritual characteristics of the Holy Spirit of God. Without the Holy Spirit there can be no wisdom, knowledge and understanding. And without the spirit of might or power, there can be no healing power to heal anyone. When these teachers are teaching nonsense, you'll know that they don't have

the Spirit of Fear in them. When God don't chastise them, they'll never know the fear of the Lord. But, God only chastise those whom he calls Son. Those who are not in His kingdom will never be chastised for now, they will only face the judgement of God. So God created a delusion that they will believe their own lies for a wicked generation because they do not love the truth.

2 Thessalonians 2:9-12 (New International Version)

9 The coming of the lawless one will be in accordance with how Satan works. He will use all sorts of displays of power through signs and wonders that serve the lie, 10 and all the ways that wickedness deceives those who are perishing. They perish because they refused to love the truth and so be saved. 11 For this reason God sends them a powerful delusion so that they will believe the lie 12 and so that all will be condemned who have not believed the truth but have delighted in wickedness.

Isaiah 11:2 (New King James Version)

2 The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him,

The Spirit of wisdom and understanding,

The Spirit of counsel and might,

The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

Those who have the Holy Spirit of God will naturally have the Spirit of the Fear of the Lord in them. That's why they don't utter worthless words. Words that are not truth but tickles the ears of the hearer. Good sounding words that can never bless anyone except entertain and motivate for an hour. So, then what is the power of the Holy Spirit?

John 14:26 (New International Version)

26 But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

1 John 2:27 (New International Version)

27 As for you, the anointing you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things and as that anointing is real, not counterfeit—just as it has taught you, remain in him.

John 16:13 (New International Version)

13 But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

Many people were told the minute they received Jesus as their Saviour, that very moment they received the Holy Spirit. But, that's not true; only Cornelius and Jesus received the Holy Spirit the minute they were to be baptised. The rest had to be prayed for, as can be found in the Book of Acts. By saying that you automatically have the Holy Spirit the minute you said the sinners' prayer, they are robbing you of your asking God for the real Holy Spirit to come into your life. There can be no overcoming life without the Holy Spirit. Just think for a minute, if the Holy Spirit of God comes into you, will you not feel a difference? It's the Spirit of God for heaven's sake, not only is it holy, pure and has power, it definitely will make you feel different when it comes into you. What they are saying is that if you get a 60,000V jolt of electricity you'll feel nothing. Is this possible? I once had the Holy Spirit come into me in power, and I was changed into another man. I became bolder and a strange effect is that I began to feel connected to everything on earth. I would walk pass a person and feel their fears, anxiety, worries and troubles. That caused me pain and agony. But it lasted for 7 days. Before I asked the Lord to take it away; as I couldn't function properly as a man after knowing everyone's problem when I contact them. It was a burden I couldn't bear, And, here they are saying you automatically have the Holy Spirit when you accept Christ, yet you might not feel a thing, just believe by faith. That's false witnessing, that's not the truth. You will know when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, I guarantee you that. It's natural that you will

feel his presence if he comes into you, and don't let anyone tell you otherwise. They never had the Holy Spirit come upon them, so they talk what they don't know. Yet they won't admit that they never had the experience, even worse, they criticize those who had the experience by ridiculing them. What a wicked generation? God will not forgive them if they blaspheme his Holy Spirit. Matthew 12:31-32.
