The Bible is a very unique book. It is written by ordinary historian, Man of God, Prophets, and Disciples of Christ. Sometimes, the words in the bible can be taken out of context and sometimes they can't. Whether it's a standalone independent statement or when it is only meaningful within the context of what Jesus was saying; is important. Sometimes a simple word of Jesus could be misunderstood and the entire Christian concept and idea can be totally twisted. ### **The Work of the Holy Spirit**

26 “When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father—the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father—he will testify about me.

John 16:13 New International Version

13 But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

The Holy Spirit does not automatically come upon a new believer the minute he receives Jesus and gets baptised. When the Holy Spirit comes upon you, you will naturally get a tangible feeling that something has come into you. You can’t get the Holy Spirit because your pastors or teachers tell you so. You can’t imagine or assume you have the Holy Spirit; you can know if you have it because he is a real indwelling. Think about this carefully, if the Holy Spirit of God comes into a person how can he not have a strong feeling or sensation? The Holy Spirit contains power and you will feel it when it enters into your

body. I felt his power when he came into me. That’s why Jesus said he felt power left him when the women with the issues of blood touched his robe.

Getting that introduction out of the way, we shall examine what Jesus says with regards to the topic at hand.

John 10:30 (New International Version)

30 I and the Father are one.”

John 17:20-23 (New International Version)

### **Jesus Prays for All Believers**

20 “My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, 21 that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. 22 I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one— 23 I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.

In the right context, Jesus was only saying he and the Father is one in the same Spirit. And he also prayed that his believers will also get the same Spirit so they (all of us) who believes in Jesus will be of one Spirit in the Lord our God. That’s the complete unity, he means we are united in one spiritual accord, that is; we will have the same mind and spiritual intention. Jesus did not mean he is the same as the Father. But because of the Trinity claims that God is three in one so every scripture that contains a single similarity to this claim will be chosen and used to suit that narrative. That’s manipulating the words of Jesus, thus equivalent to bearing false witness. We must not take anyone’s word to be the Word of God even if they claimed to be the orthodox sect, we have to go back to the bible and see what it

says. And what does the bible say about false witnesses. Here are the scriptures taken from the International Society bible New International Version 1973.

Proverbs 19:5 (New International Version)

5 A false witness will not go unpunished, and whoever pours out lies will not go free.

Proverbs 19:9 (New International Version)

9 A false witness will not go unpunished, and whoever pours out lies will perish

Proverbs 21:28 (New International Version)

28 A false witness will perish, and whoever listens to him will be destroyed forever.

There are three levels of false witnessing, the first level is that the false witnessing person will be only punished and only he will suffer God's wrath but he will not perish. I have seen God took a pastor's leg for taking money for healing. The second level is that the false witnessing person will be punished by God and perish in death. I have seen God strike the man of God with cancer to take his life. Yet, the third level of false witnessing is that the man of God and his entire congregation will be destroyed by God. This, I have yet to see. But the Prosperity Gospel is a pretty close contender for this punishment, their wealth gained through false witnessing is a testimony against them. In addition, they have also committed this spiritual sin of adding to the Word of God and also taking away from the Word of God.

Deuteronomy 4:2 (New International Version)

2 Do not add to what I command you and do not subtract from it, but keep the commands of the LORD your God that I give you.

Revelation 22:18 (New International Version)

18 I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this scroll: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to that person the plagues described in this scroll.

The sin of adding and removing is not only found just for the book of Revelation it's also found in the times of Moses. Therefore, this command is very important since its mentioned twice. Let the reader beware not to utter idle words when witnessing for God. No one can blaspheme the Holy Spirit of God and expect forgiveness.
